



## Mount Ski Gull Park Crew Member

### **Roles and Responsibilities include, but are not limited to:**

- Seasonal, Part-time
- Carry out and adhere to all safety policies and procedures.
- Park crew members will participate in a variety of tasks assigned by the park crew supervisor. This includes but is not limited to: raking, shoveling, moving snow, moving features, building, etc.
- Maintain designated areas which may include: shoveling, raking, setting up cones or signage.
- Report all equipment failures, complaints, or concerns to the Outdoor Supervisor and Management.
- Carry out and *document* all procedures for completing the daily operations and terrain park timetable logs provided by management. This includes but is not limited: daily terrain park log, terrain park building maps, and new feature pictures.
- Required to work outside in a variety of elements.
- Required to maintain flexibility in role and scheduling.
- Available to work weekends and holidays.
- Required to attend Mount Ski Gull all staff training in November.
- Required to follow employee schedules.
- All other duties as assigned.

### **Job Requirements & Experience include, but not limited to:**

- Must 18 years in age; must pass a background and motor vehicle check
- Must be willing to commit to work a minimum of one shift per week (preferably more).
- Ski & snowboard experience not required but helpful.
- General Work Hours (Subject to change)
  - Thursday's 8:30PM-10PM (raking)
  - Friday's 8:30 PM-MIDNIGHT (building)
  - Saturday's 8:30PM-10PM (raking)
  - Sunday's 7:30PM-9PM (raking)
