Roles and Responsibilities include, but are not limited to:

- Seasonal, part-time/full-time; with possible opportunities for overtime.
- Must have a flexible schedule, primary hours for this position may be overnight.
- Assist in Snowmaking, once snowmaking season is over, opportunity to continue to work as a lift operator or maintenance.
- Operate and maintain machinery used for snowmaking (snow guns, pumps, hoses, etc.).
- Carry out and adhere to all safety policies and procedures as approved by management.
- Alert Ski Patrol of any accidents that may occur. Document and report accidents to Supervisors.
- Report all equipment failures, complaints, or concerns to Supervisors.
- Carry out and document all procedures for completing the daily operations and maintenance timetable logs provided by Supervisors.
- Mark all hazardous areas according to Mount Ski Gull policy, and report hazards to the Supervisor.
- Required to work outside in a variety of elements.
- Ability to work weekends and holidays.
- All other duties as assigned.

Job Requirements & Experience include, but not limited to:

- Must be 18 years in age.
- Must be willing to commit to learning and mastering snowmaking.
- Comfortable to operate snowmobiles/ATV's around hills on challenging terrain.
- Ski & snowboard experience helpful but not required.
